PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAM

The Practical Nursing Program offers Day, Evening, and Weekend Programs.

An **Evening Program** is usually held in April and September each year. Classes meet Monday-Thursday, 4 pm- 10 pm. The program runs about 14 months.

A **Morning Program** is usually held in January and July each year. Classes meet Monday-Thursday, 8:00 am -2:00 pm. The program runs about 14 months.

A **Weekend Program** is usually held in November each year. Classes meet Fridays ,4:00 pm to 9:30 pm., Saturdays, 8:00 am to 3:00 pm and Sundays, 2:00 pm to 8:00 pm. The program runs about 18 months.

The Program consists of three terms.

Students take one course at a time and must pass each course in order to proceed to the next course. A passing grade is 79.5%

Students participate in the Skills Lab, which meets during the week at regular business hours.

Standard College transitioned to a blended online/on-campus learning environment due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Course lectures in the Practical Nursing will begin online. Students return to campus to participate in the Skills Lab and to sit for mid-term and final exams. Students must have regular access to a computer with a camera and internet access in order to successfully participate in the program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Complete the online application, along with the \$75.00 nonrefundable application fee
 - The online application includes three (3) written references:
 - One (1) work reference
 - Two (2) character references not related to the applicant.
- Submit Proof of Education.
 - Official High School Transcript or GED, or
 - Official College Transcript (Minimum 60 credits transferable to an Associate's Degree), or
 - Official Evaluation Report. Students who attended high school outside the U.S. must request to have his/her foreign credentials sent to an evaluation agency. The official evaluation report must be sent from an agency recognized by Standard College.
- Pass Entrance Exam.
- Attend admission interview.
- The Clinical Practicum is a mandatory part of the Program. Students must submit Health Requirements Forms, Criminal and Drug Background Checks, and a CPR card from the American Heart Association prior to participating at the clinical facility.

ENTRANCE EXAM

The Entrance Exam is a two-hour test, containing Math and Reading questions. Sample questions will be provided to you after your application has been submitted.

INTERVIEW

After you pass the Entrance Exam, you will have an interview with the Admissions Office. Here, you will be provided with comprehensive information about the Program and complete an Interview Form.

The total cost for the Practical Nursing is \$20,316.00, which includes tuition and books. A FLEXIBLE PAYMENT PLAN IS AVAILABLE FOR TUITION AND SCHOOL FEES. WE ACCEPT CREDIT CARD PAYMENT AND PERSONAL CHECKS.
