



## **LPN to RN Transition Program Health Insurance Requirement Policy**

Students enrolled in the LPN to RN Transition Program at Standard Healthcare Services, College of Nursing are required to obtain and maintain active personal health insurance coverage prior to the start of clinical experiences and throughout their participation in clinical education activities.

**1. Mandatory Health Insurance Coverage**

All students participating in clinical experiences must maintain active health insurance coverage.

**2. Proof of Insurance**

Students must provide documentation demonstrating current health insurance coverage prior to the start of clinical experiences. Acceptable documentation may include:

- A copy of an insurance card;
- A policy declaration page; or
- Other official verification of coverage.

**3. Continuous Coverage Requirement**

Students are responsible for maintaining uninterrupted health insurance coverage throughout all clinical portions of the program.

**4. Student Responsibility**

The College does not provide health insurance coverage for students and is not responsible for medical expenses incurred by students during clinical education activities or enrollment in the program.

**5. Failure to Maintain Coverage**

Students who fail to provide proof of health insurance coverage or who fail to maintain required coverage may be prohibited from participating in clinical experiences until compliance is achieved.

**6. Notification of Changes**

Students must promptly notify the College if their health insurance coverage changes, lapses, or is terminated and must provide updated proof of coverage.
