Practical Nursing First-Course Refund Provision

As an exception to the Standard Healthcare Services, College of Nursing Institutional Refund Policy, a student enrolled in the Practical Nursing Program who withdraws while enrolled in Anatomy & Physiology, or who does not successfully complete Anatomy & Physiology and does not progress to the next course, will be financially responsible for the cost of Anatomy & Physiology and the first term technology fee.

If the student has paid an amount that exceeds the cost of Anatomy & Physiology and the applicable technology fee, the student will receive a full refund of the excess amount.

This provision applies only to students who do not begin attendance in the course immediately following Anatomy & Physiology. Once a student begins attendance in the next course in the Practical Nursing Program, the College's Institutional Refund Policy applies.

For students receiving federal student aid, the College will separately determine the amount of federal student aid earned in accordance with the applicable Return of Title IV Funds requirements. The calculation of federal student aid earned is separate from the calculation of institutional charges under this provision.
